

Wandatrak Tracking Information



When a person who is suffering from Dementia starts to wander from their place of residence we recommend that they wear either a tracking watch or pendant.

The tracking watch / pendant emits a pulse using a specific frequency. This pulse is detected using a Radio Tracking Unit and a Directional Finding Aerial. The closer the watch / pendant is to the Tracking Unit, the stronger the pulse will be heard.



When called, the Search and Rescue teams will go to a local highpoint close to the missing person's residence and, using the Radio Tracking Unit, will be able to locate a signal from the pendant. Search and Rescue teams will then be directed into that area to locate the missing person.

WHEN THEY GO MISSING

- Call 111 - Police
- Advise that a person suffering from Dementia has gone missing.
- Confirm that they are wearing a WandaTrak Pendant / Watch.
- Ask for Police Search and Rescue to be sent to your place.
